Keeping Your Family Safe And Healthy This Spring

The World Health Organization believes that up to 60% of indoor allergies are caused by molds. The damp, dark conditions in the circulating central air system are ideal for being one of the largest sources of mold growth in homes. The circulating fan of the system can then push "millions" of mold spores / enzymes into the air stream that then can lead to allergies. Other conditions complicate the problem of indoor mold including illnesses. Moisture from the clothes washer and dryer, dishwasher, bathing / showering, and indoor water use accelerates the growth of mold in walls, curtains, furniture, carpeting, etc.

A Few Likely Illnesses Caused by Indoor Organisms

Illness

1. Eye & Upper respiratory irritants (rhinitis, sinusitis & otitis)
2. Pneumonia (infection of lower lung)
3. Asthma inflammation of breathing tubes
4. Allergic alveolitis (inflammation of lower lung)
5. Humidifier fever (flu-like illness with headaches & fatigue)
6. Histoplasmosis (flu-like symptoms)
7. Allergic bronchopulmonary aspergillosis (complicated form of asthma)
8. Dermatitis, eczema, rash (inflammation of the skin)
9. Mycotoxicosis (inflammation of heart caused by toxic reaction to molds)

Likely Biological Causes

1. Molds & fungi, dander, dust mite & insect excretions, viruses and feathers
2. Viruses & Bacteria
3. Molds & fungi, dander, dust mite & insect excretions & feathers
4. Molds & fungi, bacteria, dust mite & insect excretions
5. Molds, fungi & bacteria
6. Fungus in soil mixed with bird droppings
7. Fungi, aspergillus fumigatus common in house dust
8. Dust mite & insect excretions, dander & feathers
9. Caused by a specific mold
